In 1884 a German immigrant, Wilhelm Hasse founded the Moctezuma Brewery in Veracruz, Mexico.

Thirteen years later, he created a beer named Siglo XX (20th century) to celebrate the upcoming century. With the start of the new century, the beer was named "Dos Equis", which means two Xs.
