Maison André Goichot, based in Beaune, is a family-run négociant-éleveur with a long-standing reputation for crafting precise, site-reflective wines across the Côte d'Or. The fruit for this wine comes from gravelly, alluvial soils on the lower slopes of Chorey-lès-Beaune, known for producing Pinot Noir with brightness and supple texture. Vinification is carried out in temperature-controlled vats with gentle extraction, followed by ageing in French oak barrels, primarily made from this type of wood, to preserve fruit clarity while adding subtle complexity.
