





## BRIOTTET LIQUEUR DE LITCHI (LYCHEE)

Founded in 1836 by Jean-Baptiste Briottet in Dijon, Maison Briottet has remained a family-owned distillery for nearly two centuries. Initially a wine house, it was the creation of the Crème de Cassis in 1841 that elevated Briottet to a household name in its home in Burgundy. The family began expanding the production of its liqueurs, with their popularity eclipsing that of its wine leading to the family to eventually end its wine producing activities by the 1940s.

Having gained a reputation for crafting high quality liqueurs, the distillery under the stewardship of Edmond Briottet, after whom the brand is still named, began expanding their range of liqueurs. The Liqueur de Litchi Is Briottet's flagship lychee liqueur made from the fruits of the Litchi Chinesis tree, first cultivated over 2000 years ago. Hand selected lychee fruits are carefully macerated in neutral alcohol before being blended with sugar to create a clear liqueur that perfectly reflects the tropical aromas and flavours of the exotic fruit.
